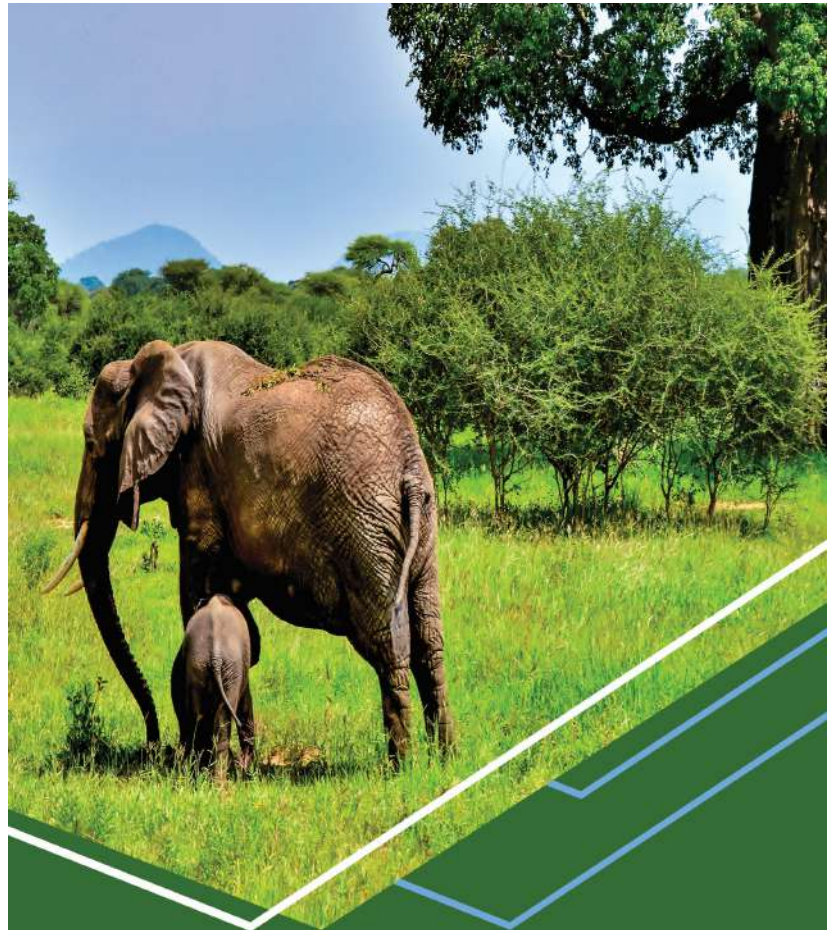

from the Pastor's Desk - 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It seems as if every time we try to plan ahead, to even catch up on things we need to do, there's always something else coming up to derail our plans. I am often reminded of the saying attributed to St. (Mother) Theresa or Calcutta, "If you want to make God laugh, tell Him your plans."

Back in the Spring, I enrolled, as a non-matriculating part-time student, at St. Joseph's College, and registered for two online courses, used the money I had saved for this, and thought everything would be fine. While my workload here at the parish was significant, I had a few hours a week that I could devote to improving myself academically. Then over the Summer, I was informed that the pastor of Resurrection in Farmingville, Fr. Gonzalo, would be taking on an additional assignment, as Vice-Rector of the minor seminary in Douglaston, and asked if I would help out. Of course, priests are called to serve, and so the two priests at St. Joseph the Worker and myself are providing Mass and Sacramental coverage during the week for Farmingville.

Even though the schedule here at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is already difficult, and the additional responsibilities of helping out at another parish make taking classes seem like an impossible task, there is one thing I have come to learn; with God, all things are possible. Another aspect of this is to recognize that there are things beyond our own ability, and when they are accomplished, we need to give praise where it belongs, with God.

There are many people who have expressed surprise and admiration at the way the parish has developed over the previous four years; some thought that it had been closed or abandoned.

Even some people working at the diocesan level thought that the best action would have been to close and sell, because they did not think it was possible for the parish to thrive again. Fortunately, a phone call four and a half years ago, from Bishop Barres and Bishop Brennan, asked if I would undertake the challenge of reviving Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and become the pastor. For four years now, Bishop Barres has lent his support and encouragement to this parish, and has been extremely happy about everything that has taken place here, every time I see him.

Now with the added success of our Spanish Ministry, the diocese decided to assign Fr. Freddy Lozano here, as a shared Associate Pastor. His position is to minister to the people of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, St. Frances Cabrini in Coram, St. John Nepomucene in Bohemia, as well as to rebuild the Hispanic Apostolate of Brookhaven Township. As time goes on, various other diocesan activities will be taking place at our parish, and the community will benefit from everything that is offered.

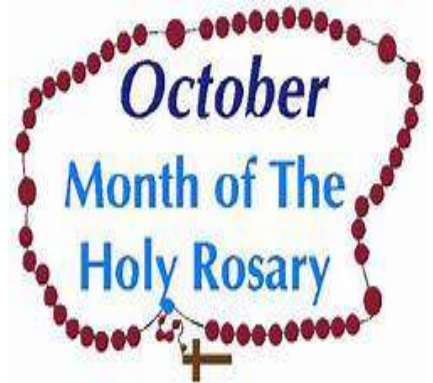
Already in November and December, the diocesan Office of Faith Formation and Evangelization will be offering Friday evening lectures on the Second Vatican Council here at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. We are also waiting for the adult classes offered by the School of Missionary Discipleship to resume, which have also been offered here in the parish center, and were very successful. It is my hope that this parish will be instrumental in the catechizing of this part of the Diocese of Rockville Centre, and will help strengthen the Faith of our parishioners and our brothers and sisters in our neighboring parishes.



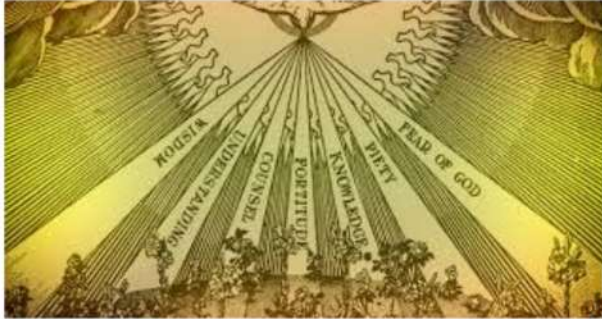
When I arrived here, I was told that Fr. Monteleone believed that the Diocese would be divided up, as Brooklyn Diocese was less than ten years before, and so he built the church with the idea it might become a cathedral. Once again, God laughs at our plans. What Fr. Monteleone left us, was a gift to be used to build up the Body of Christ in this section of the diocese, and to witness to what God has called us to as a people. The lesson? Always trust in God's plans for us.

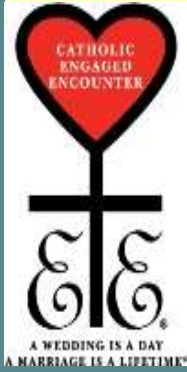

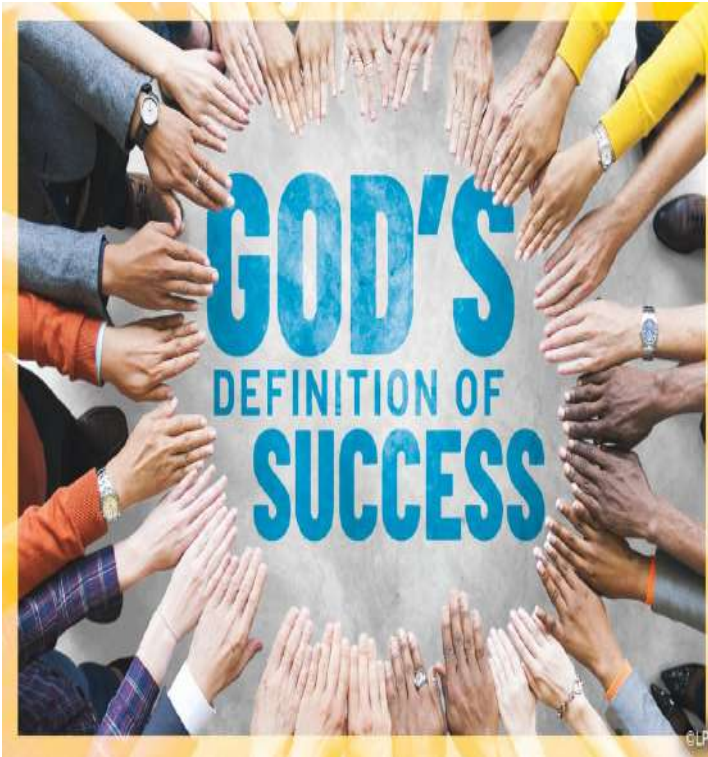
