## October 31,, 2021 - from the Pastor's Desk - Priesthood Sunday /31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In cartoons, there were those characters walking around with signs announcing, "THE END IS NEAR." Not to sound cartoonish, or as if I am overreacting, but, the end is near. Of course, we realize that October ends this weekend, and we only have two months left in the calendar year, but that is not all. We are coming to the end of our liturgical year in four weeks; Christ the King of the Universe Sunday is three weeks away, and that is the official last Sunday of Ordinary Time. Following that we enter Advent.

While some of you are now panicking about Christmas shopping, and all the other preparations (I'll admit I am too.), there is also something we are called to reflect on during this time of the year. Actually there are several: 1) What have I done with this past year that God has given to me? 2) Am I resolving to make a greater effort to live in a way that reflects the gifts God has given to me? 3) What if this is it?

John Lennon (I know, people are saying "Fr. Henry! You said you weren't a Beatles fan." I'm not. Now let me get back to where I was before you interrupted me.) John Lennon sang his "Happy Xmas/ War is Over" asking the question from the beginning, "What have you done?" Many of us can ask ourselves the same question, and reflect back on the year that is coming to a close. Even though the Covid situation is still very much a part of our lives, and it ruined the first half of the year for many of us, there is still a question of what did we do with what we had.

Did we feed into the isolation of our homes, even continuing to carry that mindset to work and school? Or did we take the opportunity to reach out to our friends and family, maybe even neighbors, with phone calls, or the

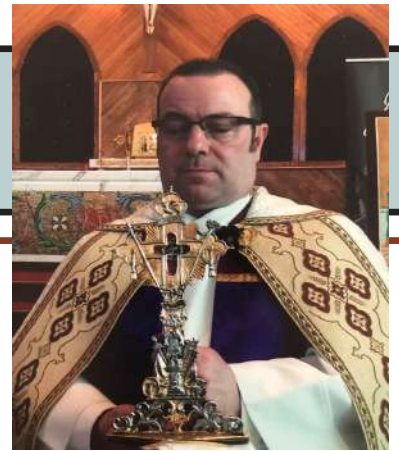
dreaded Zoom calls? Was it a time to come to know our family better? Or even ourselves? Did we do something spiritual, maybe reading or watching a film, that made us contemplate how much God loves us, and how beautiful we are in His eyes?

What about the coming year? Will it be a continuation of 2020/2021 Covid lockdown terror living? Or will we take the precautions we feel are necessary, but live our lives in relationship to the Reality around us? In relationship with the Resurrected Christ? In relationship with our brothers and sisters in Christ?

For many people, the past twenty months have brought heartache and tragedy. Friends and loved ones have passed on, whether from Covid, other diseases, age, or the tragedies of suicide and addiction. Unfortunately, many people overdosed during the lockdown, possibly because they had no one to help them, or they relapsed because services weren't available, maybe they just gave up hope. Others chose to end their lives, caught in the depression that intensified their own daily struggles with life. Whatever the reason for their deaths, we continue to pray for them all, especially over the next several days.

But what if this were the end of everything? It is something we believe will happen. We say it every Sunday in the Profession of Faith, "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." These are not hollow words, they are not even pretty words meant to make us feel all tingly. They are words that reflect the reality, that one day we will come, not only to the end of our time on earth, but the end of time.

So as we come to the final month of our Church year, as we prepare for Advent, which was known as "Little Lent", maybe we can reflect on what our Faith



means to us, and how we live it out over the next year.
